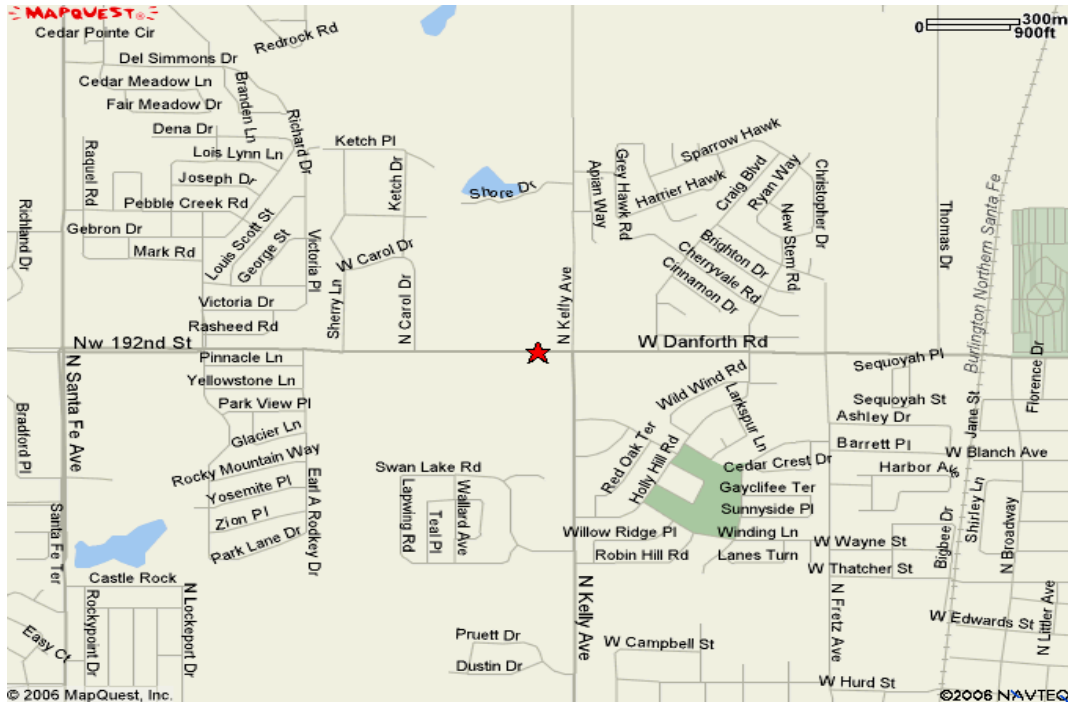

Take the Westbound Memorial Rd exit
Merge onto E Memorial Rd

From the North:

Take I-35 S to exit 143/Covell Rd
