Workshop Description:

Not an original idea to OATC – BUT.... this workshop will have you ready to implement an easy Meaningful Skills Program into your therapy, home or classroom for individuals with disabilities. Participants will be given the materials to create 10 Meaningful Skills Tubs ready to implement the next school day. For each tub the participant will receive visual directions, tub manipulatives, and a tracking chart. Meaningful Skills Tubs: provide a structured learning environment, offer routine, provide hands-on activities with visual easy to follow step by step instructions, encourage independent meaningful skill development, break down activities into small, doable chunks, similar to applied behavioral analysis (ABA) and TEACCH methods, and teach effective use of time.
