The student would use a bingo dobber or a vis-a-vis marker to indicate the correct answer. We have also given you the symbols if you would like your students to Velcro their answers.

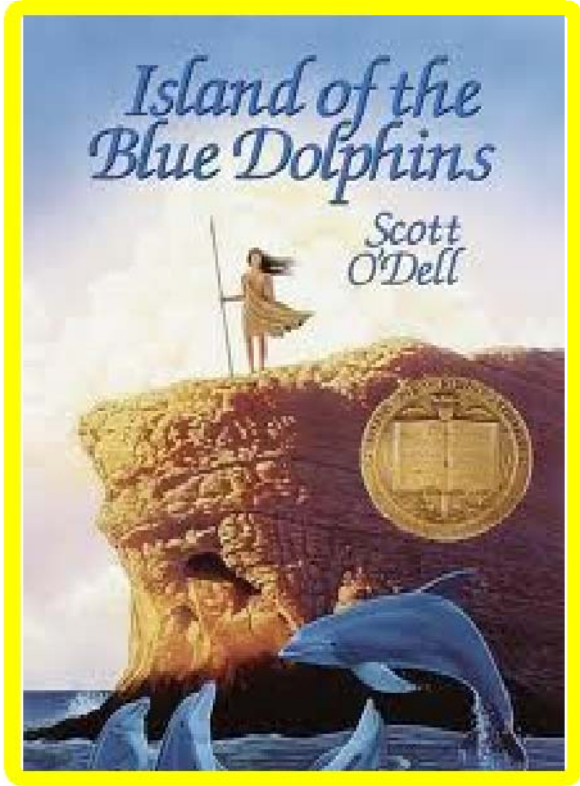
Instructions:

1. Place pages 1-3 on front and inside of folder
2. Cut out manipulatives on page 4 with picture and red square together and place a dot of glue on back and fold over the red piece.
3. Laminate manipulatives and folder.
4. Place a small piece of scratchy Velcro on the manipulatives (Both picture and red side.)
5. Place soft Velcro pieces on answer fields.
6. Place manipulatives on the back of folder when not in use.

Items Needed:

- 5 hard Velcro dots cut in half
- 6 soft Velcro dots cut in half
- 1 folder
- Glue, lamination, scissors

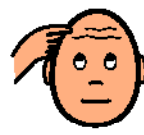
