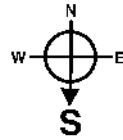




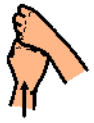
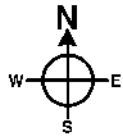
Southern States wanted slavery.

US History 8.10 Political differences leading to Civil War performance level 3 This activity is designed to allow students to identify political differences leading to the Civil War. Instructions: Make sure Boardmaker is in Design mode (if needed, press CTRL + D or ESC to change to Design Mode). Print pages 1-2 (**Note, this will print just fine in black and white!) Glue page 1 inside file folder and laminate. Page 2 are the answers. Cut answers out and laminate. Use these answers as manipulatives for student to place in designated answer boxes. Velcro can be used to keep answers secure. **remember that scratchy Velcro is used on manipulatives and soft Velcro in answer boxes.
