Workshop Description:

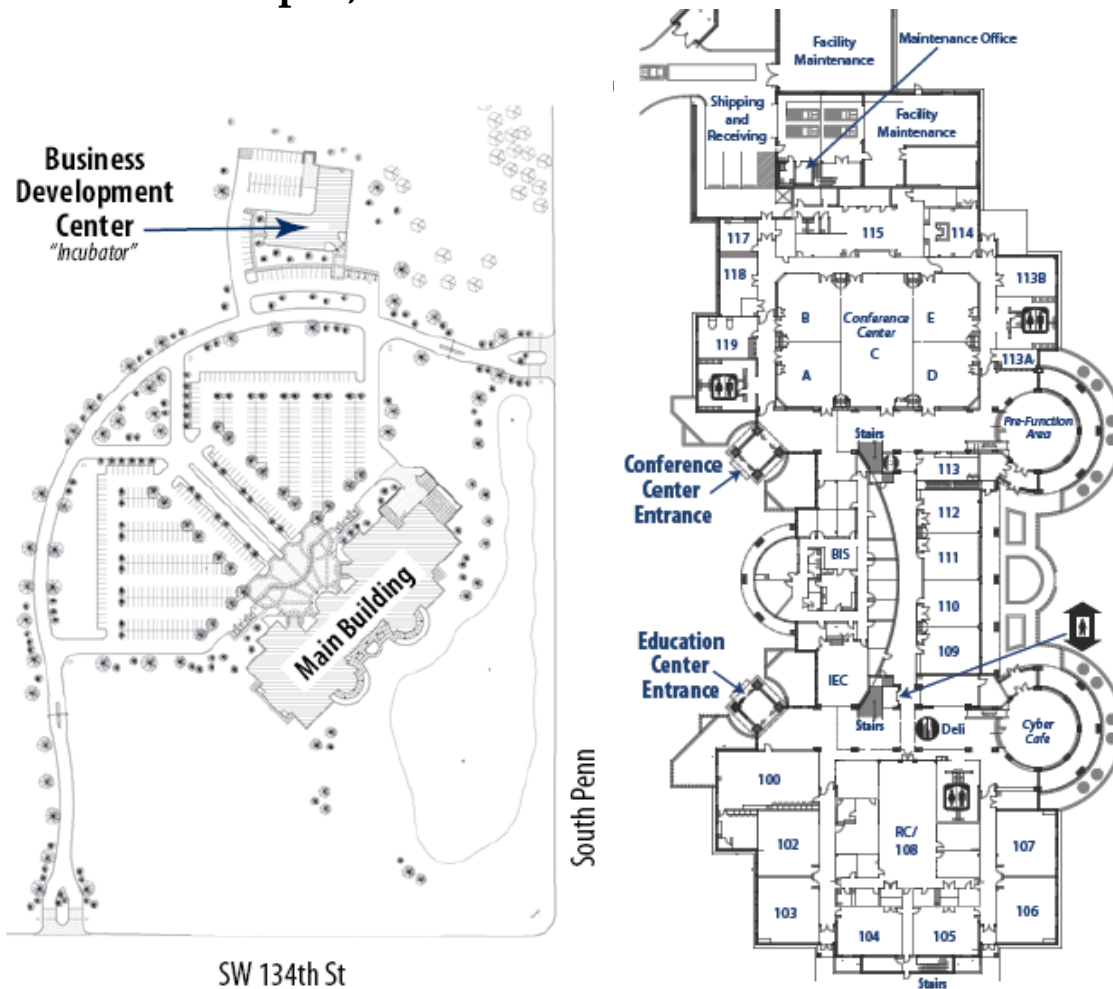
This workshop will provide an overview of OK Funding for AT - A Guide to Solving the Funding Puzzle and Getting Assistive Technology in Oklahoma. The training will discuss various public and private funding sources for assistive technology (AT). Information will include the focus that each program has in relation to AT, eligibility, AT devices provided, AT services provided, application and appeals process along with "pieces of the puzzle." The workshop will help participants understand differences between various funding sources to secure assistive technology in a more effective and efficient manner. Participants and presenters will use cases for problem-solving and discussion. Participants will receive a copy of the ABLÉ Tech funding manual.

SOUTHBOUND and NORTHBOUND from I-35: Take Exit 117 at SW 4th St., Moore, then travel west approximately 3 miles to SW 134th & S. Pennsylvania. The street name changes from SW 4th in Moore to SW 134th Street in Oklahoma City.

SOUTHBOUND and NORTHBOUND from I-44: Take Exit 110 at SW 134th Street. Travel east 2.5 miles to SW 134th & South Pennsylvania where the campus is located on the northwest corner.
