Workshop Description:

Success Stories are social stories which provide essential information paired with the most intense kind of visual support – video clips of the students themselves being successful. This powerful teaching tool is a combination of two research-validated strategies: video modeling and social stories. Success Stories can help teachers connect with their students, communicate clearly and effectively what the students need to know, and create true Success Stories out of seemingly insurmountable obstacles. This presentation will demonstrate how to use video stories to effectively teach appropriate behaviors, schedules/routines, language development, social skills, independent living skills and academic skills.

Jessica Roberts:

Jessica Roberts has been a Special Education Teacher for eight years and has published a book entitled *Success Stories: Using Video Stories to Connect, Communicate, and Create True Success with your Students*. She has completed a Master's Degree in Education at Weber State University and has shared her excitement about the power of Video Stories at conferences around the country. In her classroom, Jessica uses video to visually support the Instructional material and engage her students in the learning process. She creates personalized video stories which incorporate video clips of the students performing a skill along with the essential information the students need to understand the skill. Head east on SE Adams Blvd/US-60 toward Winding Way

Continue to follow US-75

Broken Arrow
Merge onto US-64 E
Take the I-44 E exit

Take the US-75 S/State Hwy 51 E/I-244 W/US-64 E exit
toward Okmulgee/Okla City/Broken Arrow
Merge onto I-244 W/US-64 E 0.5 mi
Slight left at I-444 E/US-64 E/US-75 N (signs for US-75
N/State Hwy 51 E/Broken Arrow/US-64 E)
Slight left at US-64 E (signs for State Hwy 51 E/Broken
Arrow/I-64 E)

Head northwest on AR-22/Garrison Ave/US-64 toward N 9th
St Continue to follow US-64 Entering Oklahoma
Turn left to merge onto I-40 W
Take exit 286 to merge onto Muskogee Turnpike W toward
Tulsa/Muskogee Partial toll road
Continue on OK-51 W
Continue on US-64 W
Take the Memorial Dr exit
Turn right at S 81st E Ave/S Memorial Dr
Make a U-turn
